



UNIFIED LAND OPERATIONS The simultaneous execution of offense, defense, stability, and defense support of civil authorities across multiple domains

Operational Reach

Distance and duration

Army Pre-positioned Stocks

Provides rapid supply and resupply capability while reducing strategic lift required for power projection

Force Projection

Continuous process of mobilization, deployment, employment, sustainment, and redeployment

Theater Opening

Ability to establish and operate ports of debarkation, distribution systems, and sustainment bases

Ensures commanders can determine an optimal enemy engagement strategy

Freedom of Action

Unencumbered by resource limitations

Sustainment Preparation

Analyzing the operational environment to determine the sustainment estimate and concept of support

Sustainment Execution

Providing the support necessary to maintain operations until mission completion

Ensures commanders can achieve operational initiatives and control operational tempo

Endurance

Protracted combat power employment and sustainment

Reconstitution

Implemented to restore combat effectiveness in alignment with mission requirements and resources

Distribution

Synchronizing and managing the flow of personnel, equipment, and materiel within a theater

Theater Closing

Redeploying Army forces and equipment from a theater, including drawdown, disposition, and transition

Ensures commanders can track sustainment in near real time, enabling rapid decision-making

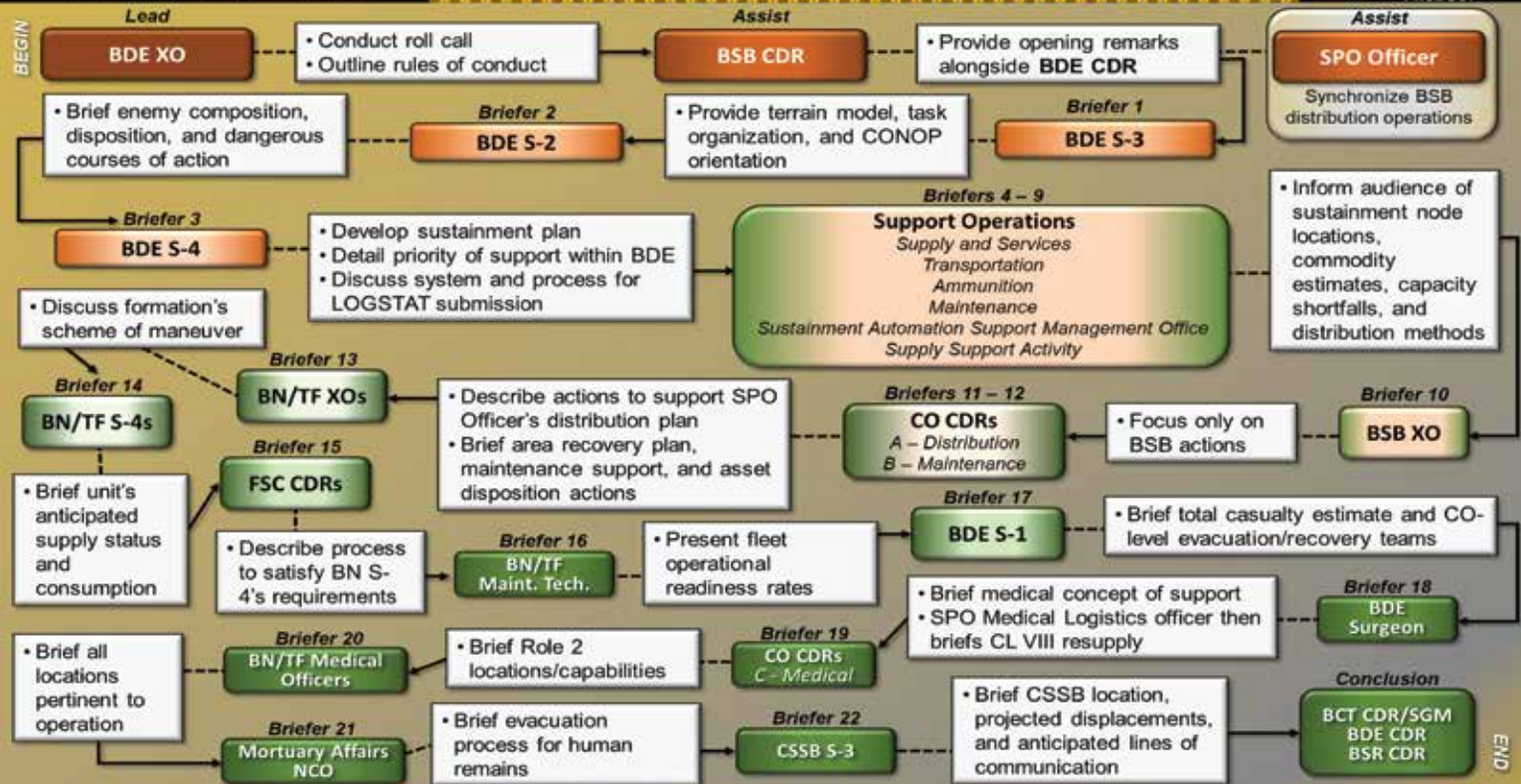
