Logistics Civil Augmentation Program (LOGCAP) is a Department of the Army (DA) Regulatory Program to augment the force by providing a service capability to meet externally driven operational requirements for rapid contingency augmentation support.

JOINT OCS PLANNING & EXECUTION COURSE

- **JOPEC** – The Joint Operational Contract Support (OCS) Planning and Execution Course is a joint certified, nine-day, mobile training team (MTT) delivered course.
- **TARGET AUDIENCE** – Commissioned officers (O-4 through O-6), senior non-commissioned officers (E-8 and E-9), government civilians (GS-12 through GS-15) and contractors assigned to a position responsible for OCS planning and execution at strategic and operational level commands.

OCS 3C COURSE - Additional Skill Identifier (3C)

- **OCS** – The Operational Contract Support course is taught in residence at the Army Logistics University at Fort Lee, VA.
- **SCOPE** – The course prepares military and civilian non-acquisition personnel to serve as members of an operational contract support cell as part of a tactical or operational headquarters staff. Attendance priority is limited to those currently assigned/to perform OCS-related duties.
