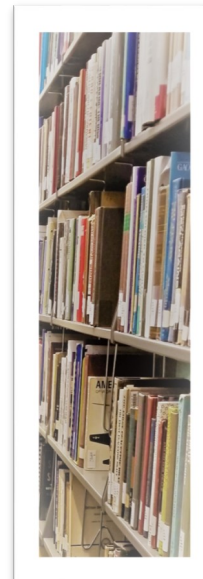
The Library provides access to the reading lists titles of:
