MEMORANDUM FOR WORLDWIDE DISTRIBUTION

- 1. PURPOSE. Provide Notification of Future Change to the Military Occupational Classification and Structure for implementation.
- 2. COORDINATION. This change (enclosure 1) has been coordinated with affected HQDA principal staff agencies per AR 25-30 and AR 611-1 for publication in the next electronic update of DA Pam 611-21.
- 3. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT CHANGES.
 - a. Deletes FA 90. Duties and functions transferred to BR 90.
 - b. Establishes BR 90. Duties and functions transferred from FA 90.
 - c. Revises Area of Concentration (AOC) 01A.
- (a) The selected position at JOHN CARROLL UNIVERSITY (W0MTG5), Cleveland, OH, PARA: 717G, LINE: 01, DUTY TITLE: PMS, GRADE: O5, 88A00 will be transferred from AOC 88A.
 - (b) Other selected positions will be transferred to AOC 90A.
 - d. Revises Branch 88 (Transportation).
 - (1) Revises AOC 88A (Transportation General) specifications.
- (a) The selected position at JOHN CARROLL UNIVERSITY (W0MTG5), Cleveland, OH, PARA: 717G, LINE: 01, DUTY TITLE: PMS, GRADE: O5, 88A00 will be transferred to 01A.

- (b) All remaining CPT through COL positions will be transferred to AOC 90A with Branch 88 as the Military Occupational Specialty Code (MOSC) secondary position.
- (c) All personnel in grade MAJ through COL will be reclassified to AOC 90A with BR 88 as the MOSC secondary qualification.
- (d) Personnel in grade CPT who have completed the Combined Logistics Captains Career Course (CLC3) or any Logistics Reserve Component Captains Career Course (LRC CCC) will be reclassified to AOC 90A with BR 88 as the MOSC secondary qualification.
- (e) Personnel in grade CPT who have not completed CLC3 or any LRC CCC will retain AOC 88A and be reclassified to AOC 90A with Branch 88 as the MOSC secondary qualification upon completion of one of the two above courses.
- (f) Positions and personnel in grade Lieutenant (LT) will be transferred from AOC 88B, AOC 88C and AOC 88D.
- (g) Association with Skill Identifier (SI) P1 (Theater Logistics (TLOG) Studies Program) no longer authorized. Positions and personnel currently identified with SI P1 being transferred to AOC 90A will retain the SI.
 - (2) Deletes AOC 88B (Traffic Management).
- (a) All CPT through COL positions will be transferred to AOC 90A with Branch 88 as the MOSC secondary position.
- (b) All personnel in grade MAJ through COL will be reclassified to AOC 90A with Branch 88 as the MOSC secondary qualification.
- (c) Personnel in grade CPT who have completed the CLC3 or any LRC CCC will be reclassified to AOC 90A with Branch 88 as the MOSC secondary qualification.
- (d) Personnel in grade CPT who have not completed CLC3 or any LRC CCC will be reclassified to AOC 88A in the interim and then be reclassified to AOC 90A with Branch 88 as the MOSC secondary qualification upon completion of one of the two above courses.

- (e) All remaining positions and personnel in grade LT will be transferred to AOC 88A.
 - (3) Deletes AOC 88C (Marine and Terminal Operations).
- (a) All CPT through COL positions will be transferred to AOC 90A with Branch 88 as the MOSC secondary position.
- (b) All personnel in grade MAJ through COL will be reclassified to AOC 90A with Branch 88 as the MOSC secondary qualification.
- (c) Personnel in grade CPT who have completed the CLC3 or any LRC CCC will be reclassified to AOC 90A with Branch 88 as the MOSC secondary qualification.
- (d) Personnel in grade CPT who have not completed CLC3 or any LRC CCC will be reclassified to AOC 88A in the interim and then be reclassified to AOC 90A with Branch 88 as the MOSC secondary qualification upon completion of one of the two above courses.
- (e) All remaining positions and personnel in grade LT will be transferred to AOC 88A.
 - (4) Deletes AOC 88D (Motor/Rail Transportation).
- (a) All CPT through COL positions will be transferred to AOC 90A with Branch 88 as the MOSC secondary position.
- (b) All personnel in grade MAJ through COL will be reclassified to AOC 90A with Branch 88 in the MOSC secondary qualification.
- (c) Personnel in grade CPT who have completed the CLC3 or any LRC CCC will be reclassified to AOC 90A with Branch 88 as the MOSC secondary qualification.
- (d) Personnel in grade CPT who have not completed CLC3 or any LRC CCC will be reclassified to AOC 88A in the interim and then be reclassified to AOC 90A with Branch 88 as the MOSC secondary qualification upon completion of one of the two above courses.

- (e) All remaining positions and personnel in grade LT will be transferred to AOC 88A.
 - e. Revises AOC 90A (Logistics) specifications.
- (1) All CPT through COL positions will be transferred from AOC 88A, AOC 88B, AOC 88C, AOC 88D, AOC 91A, AOC 92A and AOC 92F to AOC 90A with the current basic branch code documented as the secondary position.
- (2) All personnel in grade MAJ through COL currently classified in AOC 88A, AOC 88B, 88C, AOC 88D, AOC 91A, AOC 92A and AOC 92F will be reclassified to AOC 90A and retain their basic branch code as the secondary AOC position of their MOSC.
- (3) Personnel in grade CPT who have completed the CLC3 or any LRC CCC will be transferred to AOC 90A and retain their basic branch code as the secondary AOC position of their MOSC.
- (4) Personnel in grade CPT who have not completed CLC3 or any LRC CCC will retain their current AOC and be reclassified to AOC 90A and retain their basic branch code in the secondary AOC position of their MOSC upon completion of one of the two above courses.
 - (5) Selected AOC 01A (Officer Generalist) positions transferred to AOC 90A.
- (6) Association with alternate Branch 88 (Transportation Corps), Branch 91 (Ordnance) and Branch 92 (Quartermaster) established.
 - (7) Association with SI 4V (Mortuary Affairs Officer) established.
 - (8) Association with SI R8 (Petroleum and Water Officer (PWO)) established.
- (9) Association with SI R9 (Aerial Delivery and Materiel Officer (ADMO)) established.
- f. Revises BR 91 (Mechanical Maintenance) and Revises AOC 91A (Maintenance & Munitions Materiel Officer) specifications.

- (1) All CPT through COL positions will be transferred to AOC 90A with Branch 91 as the MOSC secondary position.
- (2) All personnel in grade MAJ through COL will be transferred to AOC 90A with Branch 91 as the MOSC secondary qualification.
- (3) Personnel in grade CPT who have completed the CLC3 or any LRC CCC will be transferred to AOC 90A with BR 91 as the MOSC secondary qualification.
- (4) Personnel in grade CPT who have not completed CLC3 or any LRC CCC will retain AOC 91A and be reclassified to AOC 90A with Branch 91 as the MOSC secondary qualification upon completion of one of the two above courses.
 - g. Revises Branch 92 (Supply and Services).
 - (1) Revises AOC 92A (Quartermaster General) specifications.
- (a) All CPT through COL positions will be transferred to AOC 90A with Branch 92 as the MOSC secondary position.
- (b) All personnel in grade MAJ through COL will be transferred to AOC 90A with BR 92 as the MOSC secondary qualification.
- (c) Personnel in grade CPT who have completed the CLC3 or any LRC CCC will be transferred to AOC 90A with BR 92 as the MOSC secondary qualification.
- (d) Personnel in grade CPT who have not completed CLC3 or any LRC CCC will retain AOC 92A and be reclassified to AOC 90A with Branch 92 as the MOSC secondary qualification upon completion of one of the two above courses.
 - (2) Revises AOC 92F (Petroleum and Water) specifications.
- (a) All CPT through COL positions will be transferred to AOC 90A with Branch 92 as the MOSC secondary position and be further identified with newly established SI R8.
- (b) All personnel in grade MAJ through COL will be reclassified to AOC 90A with Branch 92 as the MOSC secondary qualification and be further identified with SI R8.

- (c) Personnel in grade CPT who have completed the CLC3 or any LRC CCC will be reclassified to AOC 90A with Branch 92 as the MOSC secondary qualification and be further identified with SI R8.
- (d) Personnel in grade CPT who have not completed CLC3 or any LRC CCC will retain AOC 92F and be reclassified to AOC 90A with Branch 92 as the MOSC secondary qualification upon completion of one of the two above courses and be further identified with newly established SI R8.
- h. Revises SI 4V (Mortuary Affairs Officer) specifications. Restrictions revised to add association with AOC 90A.
- i. Revises SI P1 (Theater Logistics TLOG Studies Program) specifications. Restrictions revised to delete association with AOC 88A.
- j. Establishes SI R8 to identify positions and personnel who have successfully completed the PWO course. Association with AOC 90A authorized.
- k. Revises SI R9 (Aerial Delivery and Materiel Officer (ADMO) specifications. Restrictions revised to add association with AOC 90A.

4. IMPLEMENTATION.

- a. Training strategy. There is no change to the training strategy as a result of this proposal.
 - b. Position recoding.
 - (1) Effective dates for this action in position recoding is 1 October 2011.
 - (2) Specific position documentation (recoding) guidance is at enclosure 2.
- (3) Changes to Tables of Organization and Equipment (TOE) will be included in Force Management System (FMS) FY12 Planning Filter.
- (4) Position recoding for TDA and MTOE documents to include revision of duty position titles, grades and identifiers would be accomplished to all documents in affect on and after 1 October 2011.

c. Personnel reclassification.

- (1) Reclassification of qualified personnel to AOC 90A with their current branch code in the secondary qualification may begin on and after 1 June 2011 and be completed no later than 30 September 2011. Effective date of reclassification will be as determined by the appropriate reclassification authority.
 - (2) The effective date for SI R8 in personnel classification is 1 October 2010.
- (3) The effective date for termination of AOC 88B, AOC 88C and AOC 88D for use in personnel classification will be 1 October 2011.
- (4) The effective date for termination of AOC 88A, AOC 91A, AOC 92A and AOC 92F in grades MAJ through COL for use in personnel classification will be 1 October 2011.
- (5) The effective date for reclassification of personnel to AOC 90A upon completion of CLC3 co LRC CCC on and after 1 June 2011 will be date of course completion or as determined by the reclassification authority.
 - (6) Specific personnel reclassification guidance is at enclosure 3.
- d. Supporting documents. To assist in documentation of this NOFC, extracts from Force Management System (FMS) identified as affected by this proposal is provided at enclosure 4 and 5 respectively. Specific units and positions identified in the enclosures may be invalid in future documents and all positions affected by the proposal may not be included in the enclosures.
 - e. Personnel substitutability. Not applicable.
- f. Milestones (AR 611-1, table 3-1). The following milestones, required to update manpower and personnel systems, will occur after release of NOFC.
- (1) 30 October 2010 Close MOCS window and consolidate approved changes (ODCS G-1).
 - (2) 30 November 2010 Update POSC-Edit File (ODCS G-1).
