The Philip A. Connelly Awards (PAC) Program was instituted in 1968 to recognize excellence in Army Food Service. The program is named for the late Philip A. Connelly, former president of International Food Service Executives Association. The Connelly competition represents a personal challenge to individual Soldiers. The end result is a proliferation of outstanding effort as one individual inspires another to seek the satisfaction found in performing a job well done. The Connelly Awards Program has helped to instill in Army Culinary Specialists a sense of prestige and dignity. The Connelly competition is comprised of four categories: Active Army (Field Feeding Company) Field, Active Army (Brigade Support Battalion) Field, Army National Guard Field, and the Army Reserve Field.
