

Virginia Commonwealth University

The Combined Arms Support Command manages the Advanced Civil Schooling (ACS) program with Virginia Commonwealth University's (VCU) Master of Supply Chain Management (MSCM) program. This fully-funded, 12 month program is open to Regular Army Logistics captains who have completed command no later than the June prior to the academic year.

The VCU MSCM is a 30 hour program that emphasizes innovation and critical thinking in the supply chain management process. Students will gain the knowledge of supply chain management and logistics systems, international logistics, transportation management, enterprise resource planning and innovation processes. As part of the graduation requirements, Logistics officers will complete a capstone project focused on a real-world operational problem set. This project will be recommended and sponsored by leaders within the operational force.

Upon graduation, participants in this program incur a 36 month Additional Service Obligation IAW AR 350-100. The initial 24 months of this ADSO will be served in an approved utilization assignment at CASCOM, AMC, ESC, or TSC.
