MEMORANDUM FOR Students of the Army Logistics University (ALU) Logistics Basic Officer Leader Course (LOG BOLC)

SUBJECT: LOG BOLC Welcome Letter

1. The Army Logistics University Logistics Basic Officer Leadership Department (BOLD) welcomes you to LOG BOLC. It is our expectation to provide all Quartermaster, Transportation, and Ordnance, as well as our international and civilian partners, with a world-class education. The BOLD Cadre, logistics professionals from across the Army, have the responsibility to train and develop lieutenants as basic branch logistics officers, prepared to lead a platoon in support of Large Scale Combat Operations (LSCO).
